
Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am sending this letter as a follow-up to my correspondence from March 17, 2021. Please remember that directly after our spring break, we will be operating in a fully remote instructional capacity for two weeks to mitigate any possible spike in Covid-19 cases, as we experienced after our winter break. Then, on April 19, 2021, and for the remainder of the school year, we will offer full-day in-person instruction five days per week. It remains imperative that we have an accurate count of the number of students in each school who plan to attend in-person instruction. If you have not already done so, please take a few minutes to access this [link](#) for the Fourth Marking Period School Choice Survey. This needs to be completed by Friday, March 26, 2021. As stated previously, if you select in-person instruction for marking period four, your child will return to school on April 19, 2021. If you select the fully remote option, your child's program will remain remote for the duration of the school year. As we continue to navigate the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, things may change quickly, and we encourage you to check our website regularly. All students returning to in-person instruction on April 19, 2021, will be attending five days per week for full days of instruction, including lunch.
