Our school is proud to help the American Heart Association as they are supporting our community in many ways during this pandemic. In a normal year, heart disease is the leading cause of death in America, but now people who have had a stroke or live with heart disease make up more than 40% of those hospitalized for COVID-19. The AHA has already funded \$2.5 Million in fast-response grants to study COVID-19's effects on heart disease patients, launched a COVID-19 Data Registry within the Get with the Guidelines registry that is used by hundreds of hospitals nation-wide. This has made it possible to learn from COVID patients quickly and improve treatments more rapidly. The more that is discovered, the more research is needed.

As always, your student's heart health and the health of others is a priority of ours. Start now by taking a heart healthy pledge; choose to Be Kind; Drink Water; or Move More. Although fundraising is not mandatory, we always encourage our students to do their best.
